AGES:

Naciwonki Summer Adventures is appropriate for children entering Kindergarten through 5th grade.

WHAT WILL YOUR CHILD BE DOING?

Each day will consist of scheduled activities based on weekly themes. Children will have the opportunity to do arts and crafts projects, team building activities, water activities and indoor/outdoor games. We will have dress up days and popsicle Fridays! Weekly swimming and field trips will be determined by local health and state guidelines. We will provide all families with information as we receive it!



WHAT TO BRING TO NSA?
