Counselor-In-Training

Entering Grade 9-10 • Runs Sessions 1-4 and 5-8

Our future leaders, Counselors-in-Training, spend four weeks (sessions 1-4 **OR** 5-8) -Training and working with campers and camp staff. They will develop leadership skills, personal values, teambuilding and communication skills along the way. Being a CIT is also a great way to fulfill volunteer hours for church or other community organizations. Candidates must fill out a CIT application and be interviewed by the CIT and camp director.

General Information

Before and After Care

Before and After Care is available for an additional fee of \$60.00 per week for Before Care; \$66.00 per week for After Care; and \$100.00 per week for both Before AND After Care. (This is the pricing for Full Members) Before and After Care takes place at Camp. Before Care runs from 6:30 AM to 8:45 AM and After Care runs from 3 PM to 6 PM. Before and After Care is NOT available for Little Rangers.

Attire

Campers should bring a backpack, bathing suit, towel, water bottle, and lunch each day. Camper's name should be clearly marked on all belongings including clothing. Open-toed sandals or shoes are not permitted at any time. Camp T-shirts are required for field trips and can be purchased at camp for \$10.00. Campers should apply sunscreen or bug repellent before coming to camp each morning. Campers who need to reapply during the day should fill out a Sunscreen Form and bring the extra lotion to first aid or camp office.

Field Trips/Special Guests

Rascals will enjoy a special guest at camp on field trip days. Mountaineers, Wranglers, Pathfinders, CITs and most specialty camps will participate in field trips/special guests which will be detailed in a weekly newsletter that will be distributed via email at the beginning of each session. All campers need a YMCA Camp Quinnipiac t-shirt for field trips. YMCA Camp Quinnipiac t-shirts can be purchased at YMCA Camp Quinnipiac for \$10.00. All campers leaving camp on field trip days will have to have a permission slip completed prior to each trip. **Subject to change based on state and local health recommendations.**

Family Night

YMCA Camp Quinnipiac invites all families to its Family Night on July 20, 2022. Family Night is a great way for families to meet with their camper's counselor and enjoy an evening at YMCA Camp Quinnipiac. Family Night begins at 6PM and ends at 8PM. Feel free to bring a picnic-style dinner. All campers are invited to Family Night; we look forward to seeing you there! **Subject to change based on state and local health recommendations.**

Important Information

YMCA Camp Quinnipiac is a state-licensed day camp. The camp day runs from 8:45 AM to 3 PM. Before Care runs from 6:30 AM to 8:45 AM. After Care runs from 3 PM to 6 PM. Campers not participating in Before Care can be dropped off beginning at 8:45 AM. Campers not participating in After Care must be picked up by 3 PM.

Payment Schedule

A \$50 non-refundable deposit per session is required upon registration for camp. **AFTER APRIL 22, 2022 DEPOSITS WILL BE TRANSFERABLE BETWEEN SESSIONS BUT NOT REFUNDABLE IF A CAMP SESSION IS CANCELLED. The remaining balance is due in full, TWO WEEKS prior to the start of each session. A \$10 late fee will be assessed on all payments made after the deadline.** Please address all questions or concerns regarding camp payments to Susan Cagno at 860.426.9590. **ALL CAMPERS MUST BE REGISTERED BY 3 PM ON THE FRIDAY PRIOR TO THE SESSION STARTING. A \$25 LATE FEE WILL BE CHARGED IF YOU SIGN UP THE MONDAY MORNING OF THE SESSION. THERE WILL BE A \$7 CHANGE FEE APPLIED TO ANY SESSION CHANGED.**

Medical Forms

State law requires that all campers have a medical form completed by a physician and submitted to the Cheshire Community YMCA prior to the child's first day of camp. **NOTE: The physical must be valid within 3 years of the first day of camp, June 13, 2022 ***MEDICAL FORMS ARE DUE THE MONDAY PRIOR TO YOUR CHILD'S FIRST DAY OF CAMP.*****
