CAMP Q GROUPS, SESSION THEMES, DATES & PRICING

Rascals

Entering Grades K-1 • Runs Sessions 1-10

Rascals will do activities including Arts & Crafts, Field Games, Water Play (including Slip N Slide), Court Games, and more! This group will also meet fellow campers they may see next school year as well! Each week, Rascals will have a special guest at camp.

Mountaineers

Entering Grades 2-3 • Runs Sessions 1-10

Mountaineers will take part in traditional camp activities like Arts & Crafts, Field Games, Water Play (including Slip N Slide), Court Games, and more! They will also have time to get to know other campers and will take part in a field trip each week!

Wranglers

Entering Grades 4-5 • Runs Sessions 1-10

Wranglers will participate in traditional camp activities like Arts & Crafts, Field Games, Water Play (including Slip N Slide), Court Games, and more! They will also go on a field trip each week!

Pathfinders

Entering Grades 6-8 • Runs Sessions 1-10

Pathfinders will get the opportunity to meet other campers that they may be attending Middle School with next school year. They also will participate in Arts & Crafts, Field Games, Water Play (including Slip N Slide), Court Games, and more! They will also go on a field trip each week!

Counselor in Training

Entering Grades 9-10 • Runs Sessions 2-5 and/or 6-9

Our future leaders, Counselors in Training (CIT) spend four weeks (sessions 2-5 and/or 6-9) training and working with Campers & Camp Staff. They develop leadership skills, personal values, team building, and social skills along the way. Being a CIT is also a great way to fulfill volunteer hours! CIT candidates must fill out a CIT application and be interviewed by the CIT/ Assistant Camp Director & Camp Director.

YMCA CAMP QUINNIPIAC INFO

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

YMCA Camp Quinnipiac is a state-licensed day camp. The camp day is from 8:45AM-3PM. Before Care runs from 6:30-8:45AM and After Care is 3-6PM. Campers not participating in Before Care can be dropped off beginning at 8:45AM. Campers not participating in After Care must be picked up by 3PM.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE

A \$50 non-refundable deposit per session is required upon registration for camp. **AFTER APRIL 21, 2023 DEPOSITS WILL BE TRANSFERABLE BETWEEN SESSIONS BUT NOT REFUNDABLE IF A CAMP SESSION IS CANCELLED.** The remaining balance is due in full, TWO WEEKS prior to the start of each session. A \$10 late fee will be assessed on all payments made after the deadline. If you wish to pay by cash or check, or to set up a custom payment plan, pick one of the options requiring a deposit only and call the Financial Aid Administrator to make changes to your account. If you do not call, your original payment method will be automatically charged on the dates determined by the option of your original choice at registration.

ALL CAMPERS MUST BE REGISTERED BY 3PM ON THE FRIDAY PRIOR TO THE SESSION STARTING. A \$25 LATE FEE WILL BE CHARGED IF YOU SIGN-UP THE MONDAY MORNING OF THE SESSION. THERE WILL BE A \$7 CHANGE FEE APPLIED TO ANY CHANGED SESSION.

MEDICAL FORMS

Connecticut state law requires all campers to have a medical form completed by a physician and submitted to the Cheshire Community YMCA prior to the child's first day of camp. NOTE: The physical must be valid within 3 years of the first day of camp, June 19, 2023. *****MEDICAL FORMS ARE DUE THE MONDAY PRIOR TO YOUR CHILD'S FIRST DAY OF CAMP.*****

2023 CAMP IMPROVEMENT FEE

YMCA Camp Quinnipiac has a \$10 non-refundable Camp Improvement Fee per child for 2023. This year's fee will help purchase inflatable activities!

GENERAL INFORMATION

The location of YMCA Camp Quinnipiac will be determined by the end of May 2023.

BEFORE & AFTER CARE

Before & After Care is available for an additional fee per session (see below). Before & After Care takes place at camp. Before Care runs from 6:30-8:45AM and After Care runs from 3-6PM.

Full Members: Before Care \$65 • After Care \$71 • Both AM & PM \$105
Non-Members: Before Care \$70 • After Care \$76 • Both AM & PM \$110

CAMP ATTIRE

Campers should bring a backpack, bathing suit, towel, water bottle, and lunch each day. The camper's name should be clearly marked on all belongings including clothing. Open-toed sandals or shoes are not permitted at any time. Camp T-Shirts are required for field trips and can be purchased at camp for \$10. Campers should apply sunscreen or bug repellent before attending camp each morning. Campers who need to reapply during the day need to complete a "Sunscreen Form" and bring the extra lotion to the First Aid or Camp Office.

FIELD TRIPS & SPECIAL GUESTS

Rascals will enjoy a special guest at camp on field trip days. Mountaineers, Wranglers, Pathfinders, and CIT's will participate in field trips/special guests which will be detailed in a weekly newsletter that will be distributed via email at the beginning of each session. Campers are required to have a camp t-shirt for field trips. T-Shirts are available for purchase at YMCA Camp Quinnipiac for \$10. All campers leaving camp on field trip days will have to have a permission slip completed prior to each field trip by their parent/guardian.

FAMILY NIGHT

YMCA Camp Quinnipiac invites all families to its Family Night on July 19, 2023. Family Night is an excellent way for families to meet with their camp counselors and enjoy an evening at YMCA Camp Quinnipiac. Family Night begins at 6PM and ends at 8PM.
