- All applications are subject to approval by The Southington Farmers Market Committee. You will be notified upon acceptance of your application. Further information may be required upon acceptance.
- The market master will assign each vendor a location the vendor will sell in.

Schedule A: Fees and Fines

3. Guest Market Site Fee (1 time per month)	\$25.00
4. Bounced check	\$35.00

Market Rules

Set-up & Sales.

- Each participating member at the market who wishes to sell his/her products ("Seller") will be responsible for setting up, displaying, and packaging his/her products.
- Sellers may not set up more than one (1.5) hours before market starting time. Sellers shall arrive no later than 15 minutes prior to and set up must be complete before market starting time. Sales prior to the market starting time are prohibited.

Clean-up. Sellers shall thoroughly clean up at the end of the market and remain for the entirety of the market.

Marketing and Social Media

The Southington Farmers Market Committee members will coordinate with local media and community organizations to promote the market – local newspaper, Town Green Community Board, church bulletins, and/or signage placed on the Town Green. Additionally, regular posts will be created for Facebook and Instagram.
